






Lessons Learned

- Scope: Adapt Accordingly
- Quality: Meet the Requirements First
- Cost: "Run Your Project Like a Business"
- Time: Plan for the worst
- HR: Clarify Expectations
- Risk: Keep Highest Risk off Critical Path
- Procurement: Have Contracts with Penalties
- Communication: Be Proactive & Transparent




Future = Past = Old Stadium

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
